Located in Rome, in a beautiful and preserved area of 5 hectares, ISD is a safe and secure place for the educational and cultural development of your children.

ISD offers a multilingual curriculum from kindergarden onwards, where lessons are given in three languages: French, English and Italian. ISD is also an IB (International Baccalaureate) school.

Our pedagogical approach is adapted to the needs of our students and to the requirements of the programs, in particular by offering 3 courses in secondary school: the continuation of the French program, the Baccalauréat, the European Section, or the ESABAC (bi-national section allowing the simultaneous delivery of the French Baccalauréat and the Italian Esame di Stato), the International Baccalaureate IB (from grade 10).

The values which guide us and which form the students who are entrusted to us are those of exigency, benevolence and respect for the human person in all his dimensions.

The boarding school Saint Dominique in Rome

The Institut Saint-Dominique boarding school affirms its desire to provide its students with a high quality education and tools that will allow them to succeed academically while helping them to develop their cultural, athletic and artistic emancipation.

In addition to the curriculum itself, the after-school activities are designed to provide coherent and complementary responses to the class project.

Numerous and varied without being overwhelming, they provide breathing space and take different forms from the classroom activities.



Our boarding school project is based on 3 major themes:

ARTS AND CULTURES

Artistic and cultural education contributes to the development of the student's personality and is a key element in the construction of a cultural identity. The Institut Saint-Dominique boarding school offers boarders a rich and coherent cultural program, allowing them to access various forms of expression, as readers, spectators, listeners, but also as practitioners.

These activities, which are part of an annual cultural program, take the form of practical or creative workshops and cultural discovery tours.



CITIZENSHIP, COMMITMENT, INITIATIVE

Learning responsibility is one of the skills that must be mastered at the end of compulsory schooling. The boarding school is interested in the elements that contribute to the students' responsibility, their commitment and their taking of initiative, particularly in daily life.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

Sport contributes to the learning of responsibility, citizenship, health, socialization, cultural skills and openness to the world. The Saint-Dominique boarding school's sports project is complementary to physical and sports education (EPS). We also work on all the elements that can counterbalance the overconsumption of screens by young people, whether through social networks or online games. Institut Saint-Dominique organizes work sessions, under the guidance of a specialized trainer, allowing students to improve their concentration, personal reflection and the quality of their work.

Our boarding school is committed to being the driving force behind the development of a quality educational offer, rich in human experiences, acquired through a community life that demands attention and respect in the relationship with others.





A unique experience in a prestigious place

Our facilities are modern with double or single rooms with private bathrooms, a “relaxation” area where community life is articulated and where students can recharge their batteries, play, exchange and read. We emphasize learning through sports by offering outdoor sports fields (soccer, basketball, badminton...) and an indoor gym.

Meals are cooked on site at the school restaurant and the menus are varied and of high quality.

Students can go to the Health Center, which is a place to receive, listen to, accompany and provide first aid under the supervision of a school nursery. Our students come from all over the world. Aged from 11 to 17 years old, they find our boarding school a cocoon in which they blossom and feel at home.

Autonomy, organizational skills and a taste for sharing are qualities that allow them to learn to live in a community, under the benevolent care of our staff and our boarding school directors who take care of our students and accompany them.

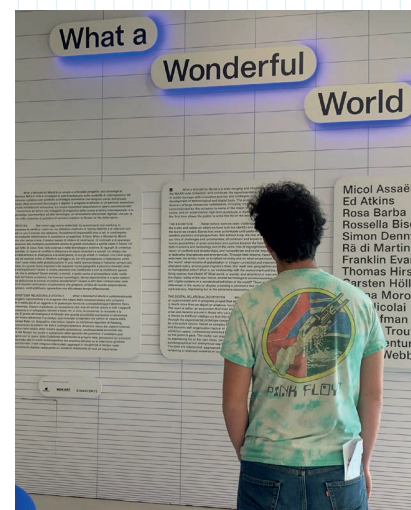
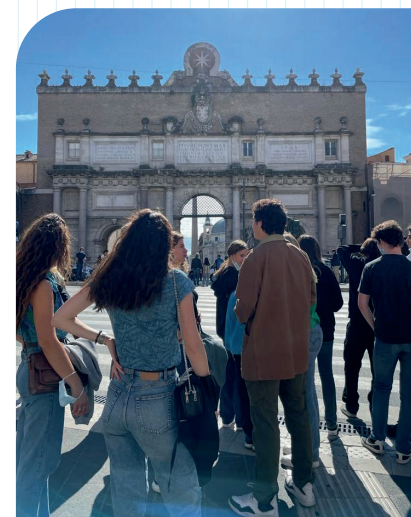


Boarding school life

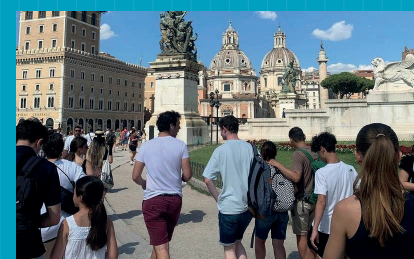
