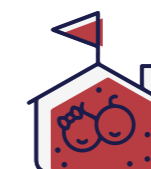

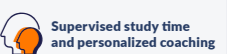

1. ONLINE APPLICATION ON THE EDUKA REGISTRATION PLATFORM

Required documents: school transcripts, photocopies of parents' and child's passports.



2. PROCESSING YOUR APPLICATION & PEDAGOGICAL INTERVIEW

Once the application is submitted and processed by the admissions department, a pedagogical interview will be scheduled within 5 working days.



3. ADMISSION RESULTS

Following the admissions committee review, your child's placement will be confirmed via email within 2-3 days.
